Schools currently implementing RtI will be showcased along with discussion about resources to assist districts in exploring initial steps to implementation.

Participants are required to attend in district teams of three (3) or more. These teams must include district decision-makers, e.g. superintendents, principals, directors, and/or teacher leaders.
